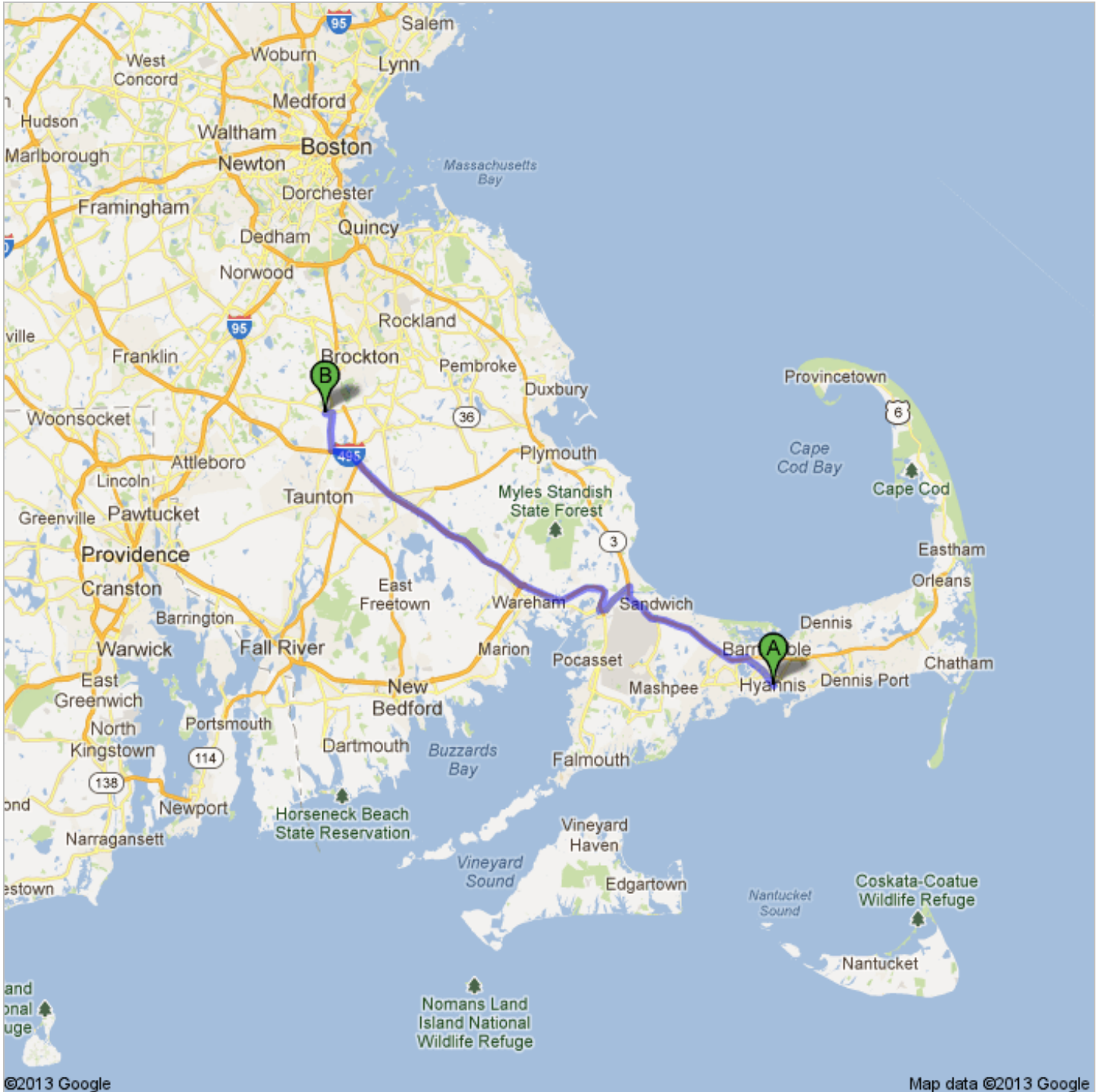














**Directions to Southeastern High School**

**57.5 mi – about 1 hour 9 mins**



**A** Hyannis, Barnstable, MA

1. Head **southwest** on **North St** toward **High School Rd** go 16 ft  
total 16 ft
-  2. Take the 1st right onto **High School Rd** go 0.1 mi  
total 0.1 mi
3. Continue onto **Bearses Way** go 0.1 mi  
total 0.2 mi
-  4. At the traffic circle, continue straight to stay on **Bearses Way**  
About 4 mins go 1.7 mi  
total 1.9 mi
-  5. Turn left onto **Iyannough Rd**  
About 4 mins go 1.7 mi  
total 3.6 mi
-  6. Take the ramp onto **US-6 W**  
About 16 mins go 14.0 mi  
total 17.7 mi
-  7. Exit onto **US-6 W/Scenic Hwy** toward **Buzzards Bay**  
Continue to follow US-6 W go 3.9 mi  
total 21.6 mi  
About 6 mins
-  8. Take the **MA-28 S/MA-25 W** ramp to **Falmouth the Islands/I-495** go 0.1 mi  
total 21.7 mi
-  9. Keep left at the fork, follow signs for **Massachusetts 25 W/Interstate 195/Interstate 495** and merge onto **MA-25 W**  
About 9 mins go 9.8 mi  
total 31.6 mi
-  10. Continue onto **I-495 N**  
About 21 mins go 21.5 mi  
total 53.0 mi
-  11. Take exit **8** to merge onto **MA-138 N/Broadway**  
Continue to follow MA-138 N go 3.8 mi  
total 56.8 mi  
About 5 mins
-  12. Turn left onto **MA-106 W/Foundry St**  
Destination will be on the left go 0.7 mi  
total 57.5 mi  
About 2 mins
